S/2011/0414/FUL – New window to kitchen, 8 Little Lane, Aynho

After hearing Cllr Brook's report it was agreed that this application would be supported as follows - Aynho PC support this application in principal, subject to the lintel and sill matching the existing window to the left of the door in addition to the window being wooden and subject to approval by SNC of the resiting of the drainpipes to enhance the visual appearance. Given that the plan submitted is outline in nature in order to maintain the standards of the conservation area the PC would seek the submission of formalised, precise plans so that the impact on the aesthetic values of Little Lane can be fully appreciated.
