Minutes of the Extraordinary Meeting held on Thursday 18th March 2010 at 10.00am at Aynho Pavilion

1 Apologies for Absence

Apologies were accepted from Cllrs Anderson, Macklin, Bradford and Anderson

2 Declarations of Interest

There were no declarations of interest

3 Planning Matters

S/2010/0206/FUL - Single storey side extension, first floor side extension with pitched roof to replace existing flat roof, 2 Butts Close, Aynho

Cllr Brook stated that this application represented a minor amendment to previous plans that had been approved.

As such the application was supported assuming previous conditions made still stood.

S/2010/0183/LBC - Re-instatement of 2 no. 17th century windows, first floor west elevation & ground floor north elevation. Replacement of existing pantry timber window. Replacement of existing cold room timber window. Fitting recessed down lighters & traditional wall lights to front & rear sitting rooms, The Grammar House, Croughton Road, Aynho

In the absence of Cllr Bradford, who had visited this property, the Clerk read a statement prepared by him. In it he stated that the replacement of the windows would improve the building as would the lights.

As such the application was supported in full.

4 Approval of cheques

The Clerk asked that 2 cheques be approved before the next formal Council meeting. One for payment for the hire of a skip for the village clean up (£129.25) and one for electrical work that has taken place in the Pavilion (£152.43). These will both appear on the next financial report.

The signing of the cheques was proposed by Cllr James, seconded by Cllr Brook and approved.
